





SUSTAINABLE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT AND ECO-LABELLING IN GEORGIA KEY ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2019-2023

Sustainable Public Procurement (SPP)

- Sustainability and social provisions integrated into the Law on Public Procurement;
- SPP by-law drafted for selected products;
- Sustainability criteria, guidelines, training and communication materials prepared for government purchasing of printers, plotters, toners/ink cartridges and cleaning products;
- Cases of sustainability criteria use in public procurement monitored and documented.

Eco-labelling

- Eco-labelling system assessed and recommendations for improvement developed, followed by the national training;
- Eco-labelling assessment described
 11 quality & product origin labels that are currently being promoted in Georgia.
